STABLE

STABLE is a multicentre pilot trial to examine the feasibility of performing a larger randomized controlled trial to compare the Latarjet and Bankart procedures for treating recurrent shoulder instability. The recruitment goal is 82 patients.

SCR

The **Superior Capsular Reconstruction** trial seeks to improve the management of patients suffering from massive irreparable rotator cuff tears. Despite several available surgical options, no randomized trials have been performed in this patient population to date. This is a randomized controlled doubleblinded trial with a sample size of 24 patients in total, comparing superior capsular reconstruction using dermal allograft with arthroscopic partial repair in patients with massive irreparable rotator cuff tears. Randomization will occur intra-operatively once a tear is determined to be irreparable.
