

Otolaryngology-Head & Neck Surgery Budget Allocation for Courses and Conferences

Residents attending courses:

- 1. Annual Emergencies Otolaryngology Boot camp in London PGY1
 - Registration fee \$450
- 2. Annual Canadian Otolaryngology Resident Sinus Course PGY3
 - Maximum reimbursement \$1000
- 3. McMaster Minimally Invasive Skull Base Surgery Course PGY4
 - -Registration is free
- 4. Advanced Airway Course PGY4(if approved from Residency Program Committee)
 - -Registration fee \$400
- 5. Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery Review Course in Halifax PGY5
 - -Maximum reimbursement \$2000

Residents attending conferences - national/international:

Restrictions on the allocation of funds are based on the following criteria:

One presentation per year per resident will be reimbursed and any additional funding is upon approval from the Program Director and Residency Program Committee.

- 1. Poster presentation at CSOHNS:
 - -Registration conference fee
 - -Reimbursement of cost for the poster
- 2. Podium presentation at CSOHNS: maximum reimbursement \$1000
 - -Registration conference fee
 - -Other expenses (travel, lodging, food)
- 3. Poliquin-Xomed presentation at CSOHNS: maximum reimbursement \$1350
 - -Registration conference fee
 - -Other expenses (travel, lodging, food)
- 4. Podium presentation at other conferences: maximum reimbursement \$1350
 - -Registration conference fee
 - -Other expenses (travel, lodging, food)

Residents that do not present at a conference are not eligible for reimbursement. Unused monies will remain in the Residency program's general account.
