Hamilton Health Sciences N95 Respirator Fit Testing Requirements (All new and existing residents)

Staff members required to use an N95 respirator as part of their duties, must be fit tested prior to use. Any staff member failing their fit test, or who have not been fit tested, cannot provide care where an N95 respirator is required.

Health, Safety and Wellness (HSW) conducts fit testing clinics throughout the year for all new residents, as well as, all residents whose fit tests have expired during their residency program. As per the CSA Z94.4-11, the N95 respirator fit test is required every two years. It is the responsibility of the resident to ensure that their fit test is current.

Important: Each fit test takes approximately 10-20 minutes to complete. On the day of testing, please refrain from eating, smoking, and chewing gum for at least 30 minutes prior to the test. One must also be clean-shaven where the respirator seals to the face.

If you have written proof of a valid fit test (less than two years old) from another health care facility on any of the respirators we use, please bring the documentation to your site's Employee Health Office. The following information must be included: name, date, model number, and institution.
