

**OBJECTIVES FOR PEDIATRIC SURGERY TRAINEES**  
**FOR AN ELECTIVE ROTATION IN PEDIATRIC RADIOLOGY**

**1. Medical Expert/Clinical Decision-Maker**

- The resident will gain experience in pediatric diagnostic imaging, incorporating all aspects of clinical radiology including MRI, CT, ultrasound, barium studies and general radiology.
- In addition the resident will gain experience in interventional radiology in order to gain an understanding when is most useful and potential complications.

**2. Communicator/Collaborator**

- The resident will take an active role in providing appropriate diagnosis and consultations with the referring clinical services.

**3. Manager**

- The resident will gain experience in choosing the correct imaging modality for the situation at hand. He/she will learn how to use imaging resources judiciously.

**4. Health Advocate** – same as for pediatric general surgery but with a special emphasis on awareness of the effects of radiation pediatric population.
